2017-2018 FINAL REGISTRATION - Registration for the 2017-18 school year will be on Tuesday, June 6th from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. in the school cafeteria. All parents of students in grades PreK - 12 who have pre-registered must come to pay their fees and first month's tuition. High school students need to come, ONLY if they need to change their schedule. You may turn in the completed forms and pay your fees prior to June 6th if you cannot come on that date. **Summer hours are Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** According to the School Advisory Council policy, for a student to be officially enrolled at Sacred Heart Catholic School and participate in extra-curricular activities, as well as for liability insurance reasons, the first month's tuition and all school fees must be paid by registration on June 6th. Students will not be allowed to begin football or volleyball practice until these fees have been paid. You may make partial payments in advance at the rectory or school.
