TSIA TEST – All students planning to take dual credit classes next year must take the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) and meet the minimum score requirements, unless they are eligible through their PSAT scores.

The cost is \$12.00. Students receive their results immediately and will know if they met the minimum required scores on each of the tests - reading, writing, and math.
