

Sacred Heart Covid 19 Plan

- Students and staff are required to notify the school of a positive Covid test or a positive Covid test of a household member.
- Covid positive staff or students will be quarantined for 5 days from the onset of symptoms. After 5 days if the positive person has not had fever without taking fever-reducing medication for the previous 24 hours and has had symptom improvement, then the positive person may come back to school on day 6.
- Students and staff with a positive household member should self monitor/be monitored by parents. If at any time the student or staff member with a positive household contact begins experiencing symptoms, he/she will quarantine for 5 days from the start of his/her symptoms.
- Any student or staff exhibiting signs or symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home by the nurse and a doctor's note will be required to return to work or school, or the student or staff member will need to quarantine for 5 days. Students who have symptoms but receive a negative Covid test may return to school when their symptoms have improved and they have been fever free for 24 hours. · Masks are optional.

Symptoms of Covid-19 can include cough, shortness of breath, fever, body aches/muscle pain, chills, sore throat, runny nose/congestion, loss of taste or smell.

If your child experiences any of the above described symptoms prior to coming to school, please do not send your child to school.
