#### Exciting Changes Coming!

Sacred Heart Catholic School will be transitioning to an online application and enrollment process through FACTS SIS. Our current families will also use this process to re-enroll. We will also be transitioning to a payment plan system through FACTS SIS. You will be able to pay your tuition, lunches, and more through the system. We are in the process of gearing up for this, so please be patient. We don't have it all in place yet and will be working with a transition team from FACTS to help us get it all set up. #### Substitutes needed!

We are looking for individuals who are interested in stepping into a classroom when a teacher is out. This could be a half-day or full-day opportunity. You do have to be safe environment trained and complete safety steps including having your fingerprints done and a background check completed. All of this is required by the Diocese of Victoria to keep our children safe. #### Vaccination records

When you take your child to the doctor for a well child check-up, and they get a new shot, please provide a copy of that to the school. We are mandated by the state to update these records and we must turn them in yearly. We can also be audited by the state. You are required to have your child vaccinated and the Council of Bishops in Texas does not allow for exemptions based on conscience. \*\*Current PreK-4 and 6th graders — you must have an updated vaccination record in order to re-enroll for 25-26 school year. Any medical exemptions must be signed by a MD or DO with their license number included.
