ASH WEDNESDAY- Wednesday, February 14th

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent in Western Christianity. It is a day of fasting. It occurs 46 days (40 weekdays plus 6 Sundays) before Easter and is observed by many Western Christians, including Catholics, Lutherans, Methodists, Anglicans, and Presbyterians. Ash Wednesday derives its name from the practice of blessing ashes made from palm branches blessed on the previous year Palm Sunday, and placing them on the heads of participants to the accompaniment of the words "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

<u>SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION</u> – Seniors have been given scholarship information from both Mrs. Barton and Mrs. Henke. Deadlines and requirements are included in the information.

<u>**DUAL CREDIT MEETING**</u> — Wednesday, February 28th at 6:00 p.m. in the Family Center. This is a required meeting for any 10th or 11th grade students who are interested in taking dual credit classes next year. A parent must also attend. Students currently taking dual credit classes do not need to attend.

<u>DUAL CREDIT TEST REQUIRED</u> – All students planning to take dual credit classes next year must take the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) and meet the minimum score requirements unless they are exempt with scores from the PSAT, SAT, or ACT. See Mrs. Henke to find out if you are exempt. To take the TSIA test at Victoria College: go to: https://www.victoriacollege.edu/Explore/GettingStarted/TSI

The cost is \$12.00. Students receive their results immediately and will know if they meet the minimum required scores on each of the tests – reading, writing, and math. Bring your test scores to Mrs. Henke. All students must have passing test scores turned in by April 1st.
