The test—can—be—taken—at—Victoria—College. <a href="http://www.victoriacollege.edu/tsiassessment">http://www.victoriacollege.edu/tsiassessment</a>—Cost is \$12.00. Students receive results immediately and will know if they met the minimum required scores on the 3 tests—reading, writing, and math. Bring your test scores to Mrs. Henke. In order to be able to take dual credit classes next year, students must have passing test scores submitted by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
