#### FACTS SIS



- FACTS Student Information System is the company that we use for student database information. It was previously known as RenWeb and you will still occasionally hear that term used but it is officially known as FACTS.
- Starting with the 25-26 school year, you will be able to pay your tuition and any other fees (athletic, band, class, etc.) online. You will also be able to pay for lunches online. In fact, you will load money into your student account, and then when it gets to a certain point, you will get an alert that you need to add funds.
- Current students will be able to go through a re-enrollment process. New students will go through an online application (OA) process. Once they are accepted, they will be switched over to an online enrollment (OE) process. Think of it like college – you have to apply and get accepted. Once you are accepted (OA), you have the following steps (OE).

We will help our families through this process!

#### **<u>Re-Enrollment of Current Students for 25-26 school year</u>**

- > We are currently working with FACTS to get everything moved to an online format. This will streamline the entire process.
- This will mean that families will need to complete forms online and sign documents online. There are a variety of different software programs and phone apps that can assist you with this.
  - For the 25-26 school year only, returning families can use the same paper method as in years past if they wish.
- Families who are behind on tuition and fees will not be able to re-enroll until all past tuition and fees are up to date. Please make sure you take care of those items. A hold will be placed on your re-enrollment until you have taken care of this.

#### Online Application (OA) and Online Enrollment (OE)

- New families will use the new OA and OE system.
- Current families who will have a new child coming to Sacred Heart for the first time, will also use the OA / OE system.
- There are specific tasks for the application (OA) phase. You will have to upload a copy of items like a birth certificate, immunization record, school records (if you went to another school prior to SHS), and sacramental records for our Catholic families.
