Born in France in 1596, as a young girl she had a strong faith and a deep desire to be closer to Jesus. The order she founded is called the Sisters of the Incarnate Word and Blessed Sacrament. In 1882, sisters from the order opened Sacred Heart Catholic School and still teach here.

Written allegations can be mailed to: Office of the Bishop, P. O. Box 4070, Victoria, TX 77903. Mark as "Personal and Confidential". If sexual abuse by a member of the clergy has occurred in another diocese, the Diocese of Victoria will help bring your concerns to church officials.

HEALTH SCREENING for spinal, hearing, vision, and acanthosis nigricans will be done during the year. The Special Sense and Communication Disorders Act of 1983 is to identify those children who need professional vision and hearing examinations. Hearing and vision testing are conducted on PreK, K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th grade and all new students to the school during the school year. A state law passed in 2001 requires schools to screen children for acanthosis nigricans in the 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th grade. Acanthosis nigricans is a black brown velvety marker that appears on the back of the neck. It is the result of too much insulin and can be a pre-diabetic condition. Per state law, all students in grades 6 and 9 must receive a spinal screening in order to detect the signs of abnormal curves of the spine at the earliest stages so that the need for treatment can be determined. FACTS (previously RenWeb) - **FACTS**mgmt.com is the website where parents can access to see their children's grades. Parents can log into their ParentsWeb account from a bookmark or from a link on our school website. Or parents can go to **FACTS**mgmt.com. Select **Parent Log In** and then **FACTS Family Online (ParentsWeb)** from the dropdown in the upper right hand corner. For first time users only: 1. Log on to www.shschool.org and click on Parent Web button - blue button in top right corner. 2. Follow the Create New Parents Web Account instructions. 3. School ID is SACRED-TX. 4. Enter your email address as User Name. (The email address you enter must be the same as the one on file with the school.) 5. Click on New Parent Login. A password will be emailed to the address given. After you have your password, log on to www.shschool.org and click on the Parent Web button.. 1. Enter the school ID – SACRED-TX. 2. Enter your email address as User Name. 3. Enter the password you received from Renweb. Click Parent Login. Several options will appear. Classroom: allows you to see grades by class and assignments; Student Schedule: lists your child's current classes and times. Click on your choice. You will see all your children listed.
