IMPORTANT NOTICES

<u>SAFETY AT HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL GAMES</u> – We want to ensure a safe and pleasant environment at the high school football games and avoid accidents. We ask that young children (those not involved in the actual game) do not play football, or any game involving a ball inside the fenced area of the stadium. Please do not allow your children to bring footballs, etc. to the game. Students are also not allowed to play underneath the bleachers or run up and down the bleachers. All young children are asked to remain in the bleachers unless supervised by an adult. Parents, we need your help in supervising your children. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

<u>GUIDELINES FOR TRANSPORTING STUDENTS FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES</u> – Students will be transported to and from extra-curricular activities by school-provided vehicles (bus) whenever possible. If a parent wishes to transport a child home after an activity is over, the parent must personally sign the child out with the coach, band director, or sponsor of the activity. <u>The child may only be released to the parent and not anyone else, such as a relative</u>. If extraordinary circumstances arise, the principal must be notified by the parent in writing at least two days in advance for approval

PSAT TESTING: Students in 9th, 10th, and 11th grades will have PSAT testing this month. The 9th graders will take their PSAT the morning of Wednesday, Oct. 16th. The 10th and 11th graders will take their PSAT on Wednesday, Oct. 23rd. Testing is digital and the students will test in the computer lab.

The PSAT is designed to measure the ability to understand and process elements of reading, writing, and mathematics. It is a good preparation for the SAT and the ACT. Students need to get a good night's sleep, eat a healthy breakfast, and be at school on time.
